Building and Organizing Community	<ul> <li>Find out what energy, sustainability and justice issues people care about in your community</li> <li>Connect with community leaders and organizations who represent different classes and races in your community and recruit a diverse leadership team for your CEC</li> <li>Hold educational and social events to learn more about those issues with an increasing number of people each time</li> <li>Speak and table at local events</li> <li>Recruit and orient new members</li> <li>Achieve your 20-Member milestone</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Hold outreach and education events that help achieve the Members' goals and build a strong multi-race and multi-class leadership team for your CEC</li> <li>Interview new members to learn more about their skills, experience, interests and energy needs and to build a relationship with them</li> <li>Develop a vision for supporting the transition to a more sustainable and just energy future</li> <li>Work with members and supporters to identify the most critical community energy transitions needed for a more sustainable and just energy future</li> <li>Plug into the Co-op Power database, accounting and communications resources</li> <li>Participate in the regional Sustainability Summit and Co-op Power Leader Retreats</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Strengthen your multi-race and multi-class membership base, providing ongoing training and education to meet Member and CEC development needs</li> <li>Achieve your 50-Member milestone.</li> <li>Begin to research opportunities for community-scale initiatives and business development opportunities</li> <li>Create and implement a community development plan focused on achieving strategic goals set by members</li> <li>Support the development of Green Jobs and Green Businesses producing products and services of priority to members</li> <li>Create a network of Member Lenders interested in investing in local energy projects</li> <li>Play a leadership role in the regional Sustainability Summit and Co-op Power Leader Retreats</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Be a multi-class, multi-race movement to mobilize and educate large numbers of people, organizations, businesses and municipalities to take action to create a more just and sustainable future in your community</li> <li>Create and implement a dynamic community development plan that drives your restorative justice and sustainability agenda</li> <li>Work with other CEC's to create and implement a regional community development plan</li> <li>Play a leadership role in the regional Sustainability Summit and Co-op Power Leader Retreats</li> </ul>
Energy Products and Services, Green Job and Green Business Development	Gather people together and commit to helping each other with a common goal, such as a) making energy efficiency available to all races and classes; b) reducing their energy bills; c) transitioning to renewable; d) helping people in their community with limited resources stay warm; and/or d) creating community owned energy resources     Identify sustainable energy needs and resources in community	<ul> <li>Consult with members to learn more about their goals for Co-op Power in your community</li> <li>Develop buying groups and sign up your Members with your local suppliers</li> <li>Offer Products and Services developed by other CEC's to your Members</li> <li>Document that Members are realizing significant savings on their energy purchases</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Bring in sufficient revenue to hire a staff person to coordinate your efforts, provide customer service and link with other CEC's; reimburse the Hatfield Office for services; and pay a share of Co-op Power's overhead expenses</li> <li>Recruit Members to participate in your future CEC loan programs</li> <li>Research possible projects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Pursue multiple, ongoing initiatives with a high functioning, diverse, collaborative CEC Team</li> <li>Offer high quality, affordable energy-related products and services to all in your community</li> <li>Raise community capital, launch green businesses and install community-scale renewable energy</li> <li>Hold dynamic green job training and career development programs</li> <li>Generate profits to build more locally-owned green energy, green jobs and green businesses</li> </ul>
Democratic Ownership	<ul> <li>Recruit a diverse leadership team of about 3-9 founding members for your first Steering Committee</li> <li>Hold open, inclusive, democratic meetings that make decisions by consent</li> <li>Gather anecdotal information about what Members want from Co-op Power</li> <li>Give new Members an orientation</li> </ul>	Hold open, inclusive, democratic CEC     Steering committee and Member meetings that make decisions by consent, encouraging Member participation	<ul> <li>Host a dynamic Member Education and Participation Training program</li> <li>Link effectively with members and build consensus on key issues</li> <li>Demonstrate ability to make frame and make consent decisions among Steering Committee members and in CEC Membership meetings.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Hold open, inclusive, democratic Member and Steering Committee and CEC Member meetings that make decisions by consent, encouraging Member participation</li> <li>Members use the Council/Board/Member Meeting decision making process to get things done</li> </ul>
